Adult Gym Equipment at the Recreation Ground

If you have visited the Recreation Ground recently you will have seen our wonderful new outdoor multi use fitness rig and gym equipment. The purchase of these items was born out of the Neighbourhood Development Plan where a large number of residents expressed an interest in using such equipment. This project could only be achieved with the support of grant funding. I would like to thank ClIrs Caroline Wood, Julie Griggs and Katherine O'Neil for their time and tenacity in gaining a grant of £9,249 from the West Kent Rural Grant Scheme. For those who are new to using gym equipment, or would like a refresher there are plans to hold some introductory sessions in the near future.

Speed Watch Update

Due to the increased number of Speed Watch volunteers we were able to undertake 5 sessions during the month, with PC Jason Wright joining the team on one of the sessions. The team recorded 90 offenders out of 1,034 passing vehicles. That is 8.7% of all passing vehicles (during the sessions) exceeding the limit. The police sent letters to the 18 worst offenders.

First aid - CPR training - Final call

We've had a good response so far and thanks to those that have already contacted me. I'm putting out a final call before hopefully setting a date for the training in late April or May. Are you interested in learning some lifesaving skills? The British Heart Foundation has put together a training package that can be delivered in community settings. The free sessions will be delivered by my wife Julie and I. We are both cabin crew with British Airways and undertake similar training annually.
