# Budgeting

As we have now moved into the new financial year, we have set the budget for 2025/6. The income we receive, via a small proportion of council tax covers the running of PC assets and responsibilities which include the maintenance of the Old School Hall, the Pavilion, the public toilets, the Clock Tower and War Memorial as well as the cutting of all the parish grass and hedges throughout the village to name but a few. We have been very diligent in applying for grants during the past year in order to stretch the budget further. These grants have enabled us to update existing provisions as well as providing new facilities - these include:

The Old Orchard children's' play area Replacing all 6 defibrillators Resurfacing of the car park at the recreation ground New water heater for the Old School Hall LED strip lighting + the addition of ambient lighting in the Old School Hall A fire proof filing cabinet for storage of archive material The outdoor adult gym equipment and rig at the recreation ground
